KALAGNY will provide a \$5,000 scholarship to up to two (2) KALAGNY law student members who have demonstrated outstanding commitment and support to KALAGNY and the Korean American community in the New York area. KALAGNY will present the scholarship on June 20, 2019 at its 33rd Anniversary Gala.

Eligibility: In order to be eligible for the KALAGNY Law Student Scholarship Award, an applicant must be (i) a dues-paying law student member of KALAGNY in good standing at the time of submission of the application, and (ii) a J.D. candidate in good standing at an A.B.A. accredited law school. All law school students enrolled in the 2018-2019 academic year are eligible to apply.

Application: KALAGNY Law Student Scholarship Award applicants must submit all of the following to kalagny@gmail.com with the subject line "Application for KALAGNY Law Student Scholarship Award" by Friday, May 17, 2019:

- 1.** an essay of no more than 500 words detailing **(a)** applicant's commitment to and support for the Korean American community in the New York area and **(b)** aspirations and plans to use his/her legal knowledge and skills to continue supporting the Korean American community in the New York area after graduation;
- 2.** a current resume; and
- 3.** a copy of the applicant's law school transcript.

Applicants may be interviewed by one or more members of KALAGNY's Law Student Scholarship Committee.

The awardees will be notified by Thursday, June 6, 2019 and KALAGNY will provide each awardee with one complimentary ticket to KALAGNY's 33rd Anniversary Gala. If selected, each awardee consents to KALAGNY's use of his/her name and photos.
